

## Directions to Rhyd Hir from M62 West

Exit the **M62** west onto the **M6** south at junction **10**.

Go south on the **M6** to its intersection with the **M56** (junction 20a), exit the **M6** south onto the **M56** west. Continue on the **M56** west to the **M53** – exit the **M53** (south) with signs for Chester and North Wales. Continue on the **M53** which becomes the **A55** Chester Ring Road.

Exit the **A55** onto the **A483** signposted Wrexham. Continue on the **A483** past signs for Wrexham and continue on the **A5** with signs for Oswestry. After several roundabouts, you will come to one with the **A5** to Shrewsbury, the **A483** for Welshpool and a local road for Oswestry – take the **A483** exit towards Welshpool. After about 2 ½ miles you will come to the crossroads at **Llyncllys**.



Turn right at Llyncllys crossroads, onto the **A495** – signs for Llanfyllin, Llanrhaeadr-ym-Mochnant.

Continue on the **A483** (you are travelling West) – through the village of Porth-y-Waen (on the right is the pub called “The Lime Kiln”) – go over the hump-backed bridge and continue (straight on) – **DO NOT** turn left on the A483 for Llanfyllin – go straight on (this is the **B4396**) – continue through Llanyblodwel, Penybont Llanerch Emrys, past the Green Inn (off the road to the right), and through the villages of Llangedwyn and Pentre Felin – after approximately one mile past Pentre Felin (over a hump-backed bridge) the main road continues to Llanrhaeadr-ym-Mochnant and the **fork to the left** is signposted for Penybontfawr and Bala (**B4396**) – see photo below:



Bear **left** at the fork and travel on the **B4396** for about 300 yards until you reach the crossroads (cemetery on the right-hand side of the crossroads), turn left (**B4580**) for Llanfyllin – go over the little bridge and up the hill through **Rhos y Brithdir**.

Continue on the **B4580** to the top of the hill (on the left is an old chapel and the Tanat Kennels & Cattery) – you will come to the T-junction with the **B4391** (signposted left for Llanfyllin and right for Bala, Lake Vyrnwy and Penybontfawr).

Turn left here, and go down the hill for no more than **60 yards** – on the left is a small wood and a dirt lay-by. Immediately opposite is a small dirt track going down at an angle – **look out for the yellow ribbon tied to the left hand gatepost for a marker**.

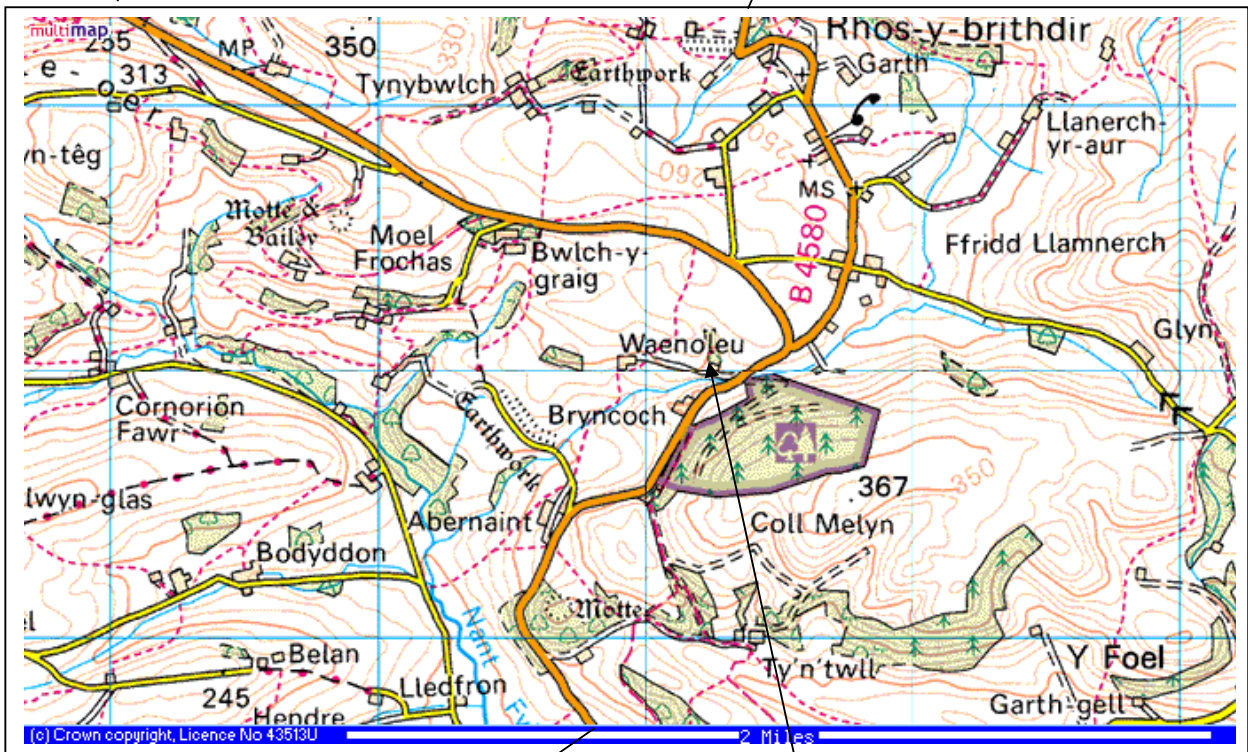
Turn right, down the track – after a few yards you will pass a small bungalow on the right, and immediately past it, you will see the gates of Rhyd Hir - turn into the yard.
